Criminal Misc. M- No. 40899 of 2016

Prayer in this petition is for quashing of order dated 13.06.2016 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ludhiana declaring the petitioners to be proclaimed persons. It is submitted that the proper and mandatory procedure for declaring the petitioners as proclaimed persons was not adopted. The petitioners were residing in the District Hoshiarpur whereas proclamation was effected at village Pathlawā, Sadar Bāga, SBS Nagar. The petitioners had never resided at SBS Nagar. It is further submitted that the matter has since been settled between the parties as the

dispute was within the family. Petitioner No. 1 is the father of respondent No.2 and petitioner No. 2 is his uncle.

Pursuant to orders of this Court, the petitioners have surrendered before the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ludhiana on 11.01.2017. They have been admitted to bail by the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ludhiana. Copies of the orders dated 11.01.2017 and 17.01.2017 have been placed on record as Annexures P-4 and P-5. It is, thus, submitted that the present petition has been rendered infructuous, in view of the above said circumstances.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Head Constable Jarnail Singh, Police Station Jodhan affirms and verifies the above said facts.

Keeping in view the above, this petition is disposed of accordingly.
