This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to complete the investigation in FIR No.126 dated 30.06.2016 registered under Sections 458, 323, 427, 506, 148, 149 of IPC at Police Station Cantonment Amritsar and to file the challan against all the accused.

Learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer to the extent that direction may be given to the official respondents to expedite the completion of the investigation and to present the final report.
