The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.13 dated 15.01.2016 under Sections 436, 457, 201 IPC and 3/4 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 registered at Police Station, Ambala City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody for about a year and the trial is being delayed.

Learned State counsel, however, contends that 20 out of 28 prosecution witnesses have been examined and the matter is listed for recording evidence of the remaining witnesses on 01.02.2017. She further states that the petitioner is involved in several other criminal cases.

While, I do not find it to be a fit case for grant of regular bail to the petitioner at this stage, however, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously, preferably within six months from today.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
