Petitioner is seeking quashing of the order dated 30.07.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Kharar, whereby his application for permission to go abroad has been dismissed.

Earlier, vide order dated 13.05.2016 (Annexure P-8) passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted permission to visit Thailand and her passport was ordered to be released subject to furnishing security of her husband's house. Thereafter, vide order dated 30.05.2016 (Annexure P-9), passport of Surinder Kaur-petitioner was released after accepting the surety bonds of Rs.2 lacs in the shape of FDRs. Pursuant to the said order, the petitioner had visited Thailand in the month of June. Thereafter, she had returned back and appeared before the trial Court on 12.07.2016.

Now, the petitioner is again praying to visit Thailand as her daughter is staying there. Family of the petitioner is looking for a suitable boy for engagement of her daughter in Thailand.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed that before

the trial Court, charges against the accused have already been framed on 08.11.2016.

Keeping in view the past conduct of the petitioner and the fact that trial is not likely to conclude in near future, the impugned order is set aside and the petitioner is permitted to visit Thailand for a period of two months, subject to furnishing of surety as had been furnished by her before the trial Court vide order dated 30.05.2016 (Annexure P-9).

Petition stands allowed accordingly.
