The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner Govind Shah under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure to seek regular bail in case F.I.R. No. 374, dated 29.07.2017, registered under Sections 419 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Sadar Dadri.

2. The petitioner has remained in detention for over three months by now.
3. Investigation is already completed and challan is submitted.
4. As such, further indefinite detention of the petitioner is not justified.
