The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner Naresh under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure to seek regular bail in case F.I.R. No. 277, dated 24.05.2017, registered under Section 395 of the Indian Penal Code and under Sections 25, 54/59-A of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Sadar Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

2. The petitioner has remained in detention for over more than three months.
3. Investigation is already completed.
4. It transpires that there is little material indicating identification of the petitioner to link him with the alleged occurrence.

5. In the given circumstances, the petitioner's indefinite detention, at this stage, is not justified.

6. In view of above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely Naresh son of Sajjan Singh, is directed to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate/Ld. Area Magistrate concerned.

7. It is, however, clarified that the Ld. Trial Court shall not be influenced by any observations regarding merits of the case as made in this order.
