In FIR No.31 dated 18.06.2016, under Sections 326, 323, 324, 341, 342, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail. This Court had made an order dated 17.11.2016 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the police official, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and custody is not required.

In that view of the matter, interim order dated 17.11.2016 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioners, is made absolute.
