The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking to quash the order dated 20.10.2016 whereby, Sections 306, 511 of Indian Penal Code have been deleted, while framing the charges and Section 10 of the POCSO Act has been converted into Section 12 of POCSO Act and charges have only been framed under Section 354-D, 506 of Indian Penal Code with Section 12 of POCSO Act.

Counsel for the petitioner herein was aggrieved against the charges that were framed vide an order dated 20.10.2016. It was contended that on account of the harassment that the complainant's daughter faced at the behest of respondent No.2, she made an attempt to take her life. However, the petitioner herein was able to save her and took her to Lifeline Hospital, Sirsa in an ambulance. However, despite being able to save her

life, she is in a vegetative stage and in coma. It was argued that the offences that were made out in the charge-sheet, were on the lesser side and prayed that other sections be added to the said charge-sheet.

During the pendency of this petition, by an order dated 13.12.2017, the matter was referred to the Mediator to see if there would be any possibility of the parties to arrive to an understanding amongst themselves and Mrs. Tulika Jain was appointed as Mediator in the said matter, who has submitted her report in the court today and the same is taken on record as Mark-A.

The report of the Mediator would reflect that the parties have come to an understanding between themselves and have voluntarily decided to end their litigation and enmity between themselves. This court has gone through the report that has been submitted.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition and requests that the same may be dismissed as withdrawn.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
