By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought multiple prayers, but learned counsel for the petitioner states that he restricts his prayer qua the protection of life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that for the protection of life and liberty of the petitioner, the petitioner has already made a representation dated 09.10.2017 (Annexure P-3) to the respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib and at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondent No.3 to consider the said representation viz. a viz. her prayer for protection of the life and liberty only.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case and considering the restricted prayer of the petitioner seeking protection of his life and liberty, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-3) and to act in accordance with law.
