Petitioner-Kikkar Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.65 dated 26.06.2017, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Panjtoor, District Moga, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the FIR, the present petitioner is the main accused, who had taken the amount of ₹3 lakhs to get the complainant appointed in Punjab Police. As per the allegations, appointment letter handed over to the complainant was forged and fake one.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I

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do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
