The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.194 dated 25.10.2016, registered under Sections 406/420 IPC at Police Station City Phagwara. Distt. Kapurthala, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that pursuant to order dated 18.11.2016, petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baldev

Singh admitted the aforesaid fact and stated that petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant however opposed the prayer on the ground that vide sale deeds dated 29.12.2009 and 11.02.2010, complainant has been duped in lacs of rupees.
