The petitioner was granted chances after chances to hand over the government documents. However, it appears that there is *ex facie* with the petitioner that she is not handing over the government documents back to the government. This Court has given chances and chances to the petitioner to cooperate with the police and hand over the government documents. However, today again counsel for the State submits that the petitioner is not handing over the government documents.

In my opinion, the petitioner has no right to withhold the government documents and it is serious that the government documents are not being given by her.

In that view of the matter, I am not inclined to confirm anticipatory bail. Interim order dated November 18, 2016 stands vacated.
