The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.397 dated 25.05.2017 under Section 420/406 IPC (Sections 408/468/471/120-B IPC) registered at Police Station Sirsa City, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR was earlier registered under Sections 420/406 IPC and Sections 408/468/471/120-B IPC were added later on and the petitioner was not aware of the addition of these Sections.

Learned counsel further contends that allegations in the FIR are primarily directed against the husband of petitioner who was working as Accountant in the showroom of complainant

and is stated to have misused the blank cheques issued in the name of complainant. He further contends that petitioner is in custody, along with her one and a half year old child, for about two months.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody along with her one and a half year old child, for about two months, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner Swaran Kaur is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
