Petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.18 dated 18.09.2017,
under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471 & 120-B read with Section 13(1)
(d) and 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruptions Act, 1988, registered at
Police Station Vigilance Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner
has been arrested on 19.09.2017 and is in jail since then.

Allegations in the petition against the petitioner are relating
to the period from 2010 to 2013 regarding the preparation of fake
documents of loans.

Trial will take its own time.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner
shall be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial

Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well. The petitioner to surrender his passport with the Court below, if he possesses the same.

In the meanwhile, State is directed to take steps to attach the properties of the petitioner according to law.
