The petitioners in the present case had sought protection of life and liberty from this Court on account of having married each other, statedly against the wishes of respondents no.4 to 8 herein.

Notice having been issued, with an order of interim protection, on 07.02.2017, as per the report of the Registry, service is complete on all the respondents.

However, Mr.Rajesh Mehta, Addl.A.G. Punjab, submits that he has not received any instructions with regard to this case and none appears for respondents no.4 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, on specific query, submits that though he had tried to contact the petitioners telephonically, their phone is 'coming switched off'.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioners are not contactable, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents no.2 to 3 to

continue to ensure the life and liberty of the petitioners is duly protected

within the four corners of the law.

However, it is made clear that in case any of the averments made in this petition are found to be false, proceedings as per law in respect of such false averments, would not be barred by this order.
