Prayer in the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Anil Kumar in a case arising from FIR No.284 dated 12.05.2017 under Sections 409, 420 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that no shortage of wheat was found on verification of the stock after registration of the instant case against the petitioner with the allegations against him that he had prepared a fake gate pass.

This fact is not disputed by learned State counsel.

Considering over-all facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Consequently, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
