Through this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.255 dated 09.10.2017 registered under Section 306/34 IPC, at Police Station City, Rajpura.

On 09.10.2017, one Satpal Dhiman committed suicide leaving behind a note in the pocket of his pant naming the petitioner and her boyfriend responsible for his suicidal death and specifically mentioning therein that the petitioner and her boyfriend were having his memory card with them containing some photographs with them and on the basis of the same they were blackmailing him and extorting money. They had already extorted around ₹2.5 lakhs from him.

Considering over all facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petitioner does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail because he is required for

It is pertinent to mention here that the petitioner has approached this Court directly without exhausting the remedy at local level i.e. before the Court below having the same power.

In view of the above, the petition is dismissed.
