The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 377 dated 05.05.2017, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 506 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) and Section 3 of SC/ST Act, registered at Police Station City Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner are that he had caused a knife blow on the back of the complainant, which was found to be simple in nature. He further contends that there is no allegation against the petitioner for which a prima-facie case under the SC/ST Act would be made out. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for over five and half months since his arrest on 14.05.2017.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Ram

Kumar states that the investigation has been completed and charges have been framed on 04.09.2017.

Heard.

In view of the aforesaid submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the investigation has been completed and conclusion of the trial is likely to take sometime, it would be appropriate if the petitioner is granted the concession of regular bail.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Javed is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
