The present petition has been filed under Section 438
Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 88 dated 30.10.2015
registered under Sections 406, 498-A and 120-B IPC at Police Station
Women Cell, District Amritsar.

On 18.07.2017 this Court had passed the following
order:-

“Post again on 26.07.2017.

The petitioners are directed to join the investigation.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioners by the
Arresting Officer, they shall be released on interim bail
subject to the following conditions:-

1.That they shall make themselves available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;

2.That they shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;

3.That they shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 18.07.2017, the petitioners have joined the investigation. It is further contended that the complainant has been getting maintenance of Rs.5000/- per month and residing with her mother who owns a house.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 18.07.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioners to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
