Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.61, dated 16.08.2016, under Section 379-B IPC, registered at Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar Rural.

Allegations against the present petitioner is of chain snatching.

Petitioner was arrested on 18.08.2016.

Investigation in the present case is complete and the challan was presented on 12.11.2016. Charges stand framed on 02.01.2017. The trial, as such, is at the very initial stage and would take time to conclude.

Learned State counsel would concede that the petitioner is not a habitual offender and is not involved in any other criminal case.

Without making any observations on merits, prayer made in the present petition is accepted.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
