The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.494 dated 20.08.2015 for the offence under Sections 389, 419, 376, 211 and 120-B was added after deleting the Section 365 IPC, registered at Police Station City, Jagadhari, District Yamuna Nagar.

Petitioner is in custody since 23.08.2015. Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Amarjit Singh submits that out of 28 witnesses, 18 witnesses have been examined. He further submits that prosecutrix is also to be examined on the next date but her whereabouts is not known. The next date for the abovesaid purpose is fixed for 20.02.2017. Out of 6 accused, 5 accused have been released on regular bail by the sessions Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record medical report dated 12.10.2016 (Annexure P-2). The medical report is in favour of petitioner. However, as per police report victim Kamaljit Kaur and her

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husband have not been found in the village.

Keeping in view the above and trial is likely to take time for its own conclusion, petitioner be released on regular bail on furnishing his fresh bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari.
