The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 216, dated 13.11.2014, under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that 110 gms of Alprazolam is stated to have been recovered from him. He further contends that the petitioner is in custody for over five months and is suffering from various ailments. Both his kidneys are damaged and he is also suffering from liver ailment. He was admitted to AIIMS in the year 2015 and later he was undergoing treatment at Government Medical College, Amritsar as well as PGIMER, Chandigarh. He has now been admitted in PGIMER, Chandigarh on 29.11.2017.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate in the shape of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar wherein it is stated that the petitioner is indeed suffering from various ailments and has been admitted in Guru Nanak Dev

Hospital, Amritsar. A copy of the medical report of the petitioner is also annexed as Annexure R-1.

Heard.

In view of the medical condition of the petitioner, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Rachpal Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
