The petitioner has approached this Court seeking following relief:-

"Petition under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. with a prayer for quashing of Criminal Complaint No.2949 of 2016 under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act, dated 12.04.2016 pending in the Court of Baljinder Kaur, JMIC, Chandigarh along with all consequential proceedings, in the interest of justice and fair play.

It is further prayed that this Hon'ble High Court may please to stay the further proceeding and all other consequential proceedings, if any, arising out of the aforesaid complaint during the pendency of the present petition before this Hon'ble Court, in the interest of justice.

Personal appearance of the petitioner may kindly be exempted during the pendency of the present petition.

The respondent No.2 be directed to hand over the possession of Tractor to the petitioner which is a subject matter of the present dispute.

For the issuance of any other order or direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case."

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a resident of Hisar (Haryana) and has to come every time for appearance at Chandigarh.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition and seeks liberty of this Court for withdrawal of the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

As regarding the relief with regard to the exemption for personal appearance, the petitioner is at liberty to move an application for exemption and in case any such application is moved, the same shall be considered and decided keeping in view the facts narrated therein.
