ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No. 148 dated 13.07.2011, under Sections 498-A read with Section 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Patti, District Taran Tarn and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is outcome of a matrimonial dispute, which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

A coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 02.08.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements with regard to the genuineness of compromise. The report of the Sub

Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Patti, dated 19.08.2017 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded, which indicates that they have entered into compromise voluntarily and without any pressure or coercion.

The FIR is outcome of a matrimonial dispute between the parties. The matter has now been compromised and the parties want to live in peace and harmony.

In view of the law laid down in "*Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab*" 2014 (6) SCC 466 and *Shiji @ Pappu and others Vs. Radhika and another(supra)*, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 148 dated 13.07.2011, under Sections 498-A read with Section 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Patti, District Taran Tarn and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
