Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioners as also respondents no.4 & 5, i.e. the mother and brother of petitioner no.1, have stated that they have no apprehension of breach of peace at the hands of each other and respondents no.4 & 5 would not interfere in the marriage of the petitioners and the petitioners have also stated that they need no further security.

In view of the above, with none representing the petitioners, the petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, but with a direction to respondents no.2 & 3 to ensure that in case of any apprehension of threat to the life of the petitioners, they would be given due protection.
