Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.72 dated 26.07.2017 under Sections 447/506/149 IPC, registered at Police Station Fattu Dyinga, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners being coparceners have a legal right to cultivate the land in question, but still the FIR has been registered. He further states that for the said grievance, petitioner No.1-Ranjit Kaur has already submitted a representation dated 20.09.2017 (Annexure P-7) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala.

Notice of motion only to respondent No.1 at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Let a copy of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without making any observations on the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, to look into the matter and to act in accordance with law.
