Prayer in the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Jaimal Singh in a case arising from FIR No.199 dated 25.11.2011 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC registered at Police Station Cantonment Amritsar.

According to the prosecution, petitioner got transferred Innova car bearing registration No.PB-02-AX-3033 of the deceased-previous owner, namely, Prem Chand in the year 2010 on the basis of forged and fictitious affidavit.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that though the FIR was registered in the year 2011, but the police went in a great slumber and in the year 2017 in the month of August arrested the petitioner on the basis of false allegations against him. In fact, Prem Chand had executed a Will in favour of the petitioner bequeathing all his movable and immovable property in favour of the petitioner, therefore, there was no necessity for the petitioner for forging any affidavit of deceased-Prem Chand. The petitioner is in custody since 16th August, 2017. No recovery has to be effected from him.

Considering over-all facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Consequently, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
