Petitioner-Neelo alias Parminder Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.181 dated 05.06.2017, registered at Police Station Jagraon City, District Ludhiana, under Sections 395, 342 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, was registered on the statement of complainant-Jatinder Beri, who mainly stated that he and his wife were away. His two daughters aged about 15 and 12 years, were present in the house. At about 2.00 P.M, his daughter made a telephonic call to the complainant that three unidentified persons had entered the house by breaking open the door and were demanding money on

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gun point by threatening them with death. The complainant told his daughters about the money lying in the almirah. The said assailants broke open lock of the almirah and took out currency notes of ₹20,00,000/-. Thereafter, they fled away by scaling boundary wall of the house while threatening to kill his daughters.

The present petitioner has been named in the FIR. There is also allegation that CCTV footage is also there.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; in view of nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
