The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.92, dated 05.10.2017 registered under Sections 61/01/14 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station SGN Dev Thermal, District Bathinda.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Custody certificate, in respect of Jagnandan Singh, filed by the State is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners makes a statement on instructions from the petitioners that the petitioners will file undertaking on affidavit before the trial Court that they would not indulge in any type of offence and would also submit a copy of the affidavit to the concerned Police Station.

In view of the fact that the petitioners are ready to give affidavit as stated above and further fact the trial will take its own time, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

In that view of the matter, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-40493 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioners are ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioners to surrender their passport with the trial Court, if they possess the same.
- (iv) The petitioners shall report to the police station concerned on every Sunday from 11.00am to 4.00pm in addition to appearing before the trial Court on the dates fixed there.
- (v) The petitioners shall give undertaking before the trial Court along with copy to the police station concerned, within a period of two weeks from the date of their release, that they will not indulge in such type of offence in future.
- (vi) In case of violation of any of the above conditions on the part of the petitioners, the liberty is reserved in favour of the State to apply for cancellation of bail.
