Petitioners-Arvind Kumar @ Uttam Kumar and Ranjan Kumar @ Chottu have filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.120 dated 09.04.2017, registered at Police Station Focal Point, Ludhiana, under Sections 307, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, petitioner No.1-Arvind Kumar @ Uttam Kumar was stated to be armed with

a knife but no injury has been attributed to him. As regards petitioner No.2- Ranjan Kumar @ Chottu, he was stated to be armed with pistol but he only pointed the same and did not fire from it.

The petitioners have been in custody since 19.04.2017. They are not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as they are in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioners in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
