Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

There is affidavit by Deputy Superintendent of Police (Rural), Patiala submitting that complaint filed by the petitioner was found to be false and therefore cancellation report was filed.

The petitioner thereafter filed a private complaint case and remained absent on two consecutive dates and the trial court has dismissed the said complaint for want of prosecution. The perusal of para 4 of the memo of revision shows that the petitioner was also absent on earlier occasions and did not appear on two dates namely 25.04.2015 and 09.05.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that wrong date was noted by the petitioner and therefore he could not attend.

The reason given by the trial Court as well as revisional Court on facts is legal, correct and proper and no interference is, therefore, required to be made.

That apart, the injuries caused by the complainant, even according to him, are in the nature of abrasions, therefore, I find no merit in this petition and the same is dismissed.
