Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr. P. C., the petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No. 33, dated 20.04.2016, under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station City-1, Mansa, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is no suicide note and that all the allegations against the petitioner, who is a lady, are conjectural. He further submits that the interrogation of the petitioner having been complete, she is not needed by the prosecution and that in the trial only 2 out of a total 16 witnesses have been examined. Thus, the trial is expected to take a long time to conclude.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, I deem it proper to direct that the petitioner be admitted to regular bail subject to the satisfaction of the trial court.

The petition stands allowed as above.
