Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.255 dated 03.12.2015, under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Mandi Gobindgarh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioner has been nominated as an accused in the present case on the statement of co-accused Ranvesh.

As per prosecution version, after arrest of the petitioner and on the basis of his disclosure statement, an alleged recovery of 840 tablets of Lomotil was effected.

As per report of the chemical examiner, the same were found to be containing Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride salt.

The alleged recovery effected from the petitioner would be construed as commercial in nature.

This Court would not be inclined to entertain the prayer for grant of benefit of regular bail.

Petition dismissed.
