Petitioner-Rajiv Kumar Sharma has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.186 dated 27.07.2005, registered at Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, under Sections 406, 409 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

At the time of arguments, it has been brought into notice of this Court that earlier two times, cancellation reports were filed and the

same were ordered for further investigation and third time also, cancellation report was filed, but learned Chief Judicial Magistrate has taken the cognizance on the said cancellation report. The FIR in the present case is registered in the year 2005 in respect of the alleged occurrence.

The petitioner has been in custody since 01.09.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
