Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing/setting aside the order dated 16.07.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hisar and order dated 15.10.2015 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Hisar. Prayer has also been made for issuance of directions to respondents to release the gas cylinder of the petitioner in case FIR No.443 dated 23.11.2014 under Section 420/7-10-55 of Essential Commodities Act, 1955, Police Station Barwala, Hisar.

During the course of arguments, learned State counsel has produced a communication dated 21.10.2017 received from the Daya Gas Service (Indian Distributor), Hisar. As per said communication,

petitioner is registered as Customer No.D 15700. She has a double

connection and is being released the gas cylinder regularly. Photocopy of said letter is taken on record.

In view of said communication, this Court finds that there is no illegality in the orders dated 16.07.2016 (Annexure P-1) and 15.10.2015 (Annexure P-3).

Accordingly, present petition stands dismissed.
