In this petition, the petitioner seeks his release on anticipatory bail in F.I.R. No.500, dated 12.07.2016, under Sections 409/420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station D.L.F., Gurugram, District Gurugram.

2. Seen the Certificate issued by the Medical Director and Director Cardiology, Artemis Hospitals, Gurugram, which is tendered on behalf of the State on instructions from S.I. Mool Chand, Police Station D.L.F., Sector – 29, Gurgaon.

3. It transpires that after lodging of the F.I.R., the petitioner had

to undergo Coronary Angiography and that at present, his follow up treatment is going on.

4. In the circumstances, only considering the humanitarian aspect, the petitioner is permitted to be released on anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer subject to compliance of the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

5. However, the State will be at liberty to seek cancellation of the bail at any stage, if the petitioner is not cooperative or if it is ascertained that his medical condition does not justify such benefit to him on humanitarian ground at any subsequent stage.
