The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 390 dated 21.09.2017, under Sections 18/29/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that only 30 grams of opium has been recovered from the son of the petitioner and the petitioner is not named in the FIR.

Heard.

The petitioner is involved in six cases under the NDPS Act and he has also been convicted in one of them, whereby he was sentenced to undergo imprisonment of 04 years and a fine of ₹5000/-. Therefore, I do not find it a fit case to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The petition stands dismissed.
