Report dated 03.03.2017 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate (Ist Class) Ludhiana has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Amrik Singh, Lovepreet Singh @ Lovi, Kuldeep Singh @ Sunny, Jasvir Singh @ Jassu and Manjeet Kaur as well as of complainant Jarnail Singh, Maya Kaur and Jagtar Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.
