Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.285 dated 20.12.2016 registered under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala, on the basis of compromise dated 18.09.2017 (Annexure-P4).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 31.10.2017 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, for recording their statements qua compromise with a direction to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to furnish a report regarding veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class (Duty Magistrate), Rajpura on 24.11.2017 and got

recorded their statements. Report from the concerned Magistrate has been

received vide letter No.1634 dated 22.11.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Patiala vide letter No.5917/AL dated 22.11.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class (Duty Magistrate) Rajpura, the parties have compromised the matter amicably, with their free will and consent without any pressure and coercion.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.285 is quashed qua the petitioners, subject to depositing costs of ₹10,000/- by the petitioners with the Punjab Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh within one week, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
