The present petition has been filed under Section 439 the Cr.P.C seeking regular bail in case FIR No.32 dated 02.05.2016, registered under Sections 304-B and 120-B IPC at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar Rural.

As per the case of the prosecution, the deceased was allegedly administered some poisonous substance.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that as per chemical report, no poisonous substance was detected in the body of the deceased.

The petitioner is mother-in-law. Keeping in view the fact that neither any poisonous substance has been found in the chemical report nor any injuries were noticed on the person of the deceased in the post-mortem examination report so, without

commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of trial, on her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/duty Magistrate concerned.

Anything said herein above shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
