LISA GILL, J.

The petitioners pray for anticipatory bail in FIR No. 609 dated 29.08.2016 registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 506, 377 IPC at Police Station Kalanaur, District Rohtak.

Petitioner No. 1 and petitioner No. 2 are the father-in-law and the mother-in-law of the complainant in this case. They are aged about 74 and 70 years respectively. It is submitted that they have joined investigation on 24.11.2016, pursuant to order dated 21.11.2016 passed by this Court.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Anup Singh, Police Station Kalanaur, Rohtak affirms and verifies the above said. It is stated that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that petitioners are likely to abscond or that they are likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. In view of the above, order dated 21.11.2016 is made absolute.
