Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.92 dated 29.10.2014 under Sections 326, 323, 324, 148 and 149 I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Rangar Nangal, District Batala, on the basis of compromise dated (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court on 21.12.2015 to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

In compliance of the order dated 04.12.2015 of this Court, report from learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Batala has been received

vide her letter bearing No.45 dated 27.01.2016 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur vide letter No.1639/RKT dated 29.01.2016.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Batala, the compromise between the parties is with their free consent, without any pressure and coercion. No P.O. Proceeding is pending against the parties.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.92, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
