The present petition has been filed under Section 438
the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.9 dated 29.01.2017
registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Division
N.8, Ludhiana.

On 17.02.2017 this Court had passed the following
order:-

“The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the
petitioner has already paid Rs.2,15,000/-. She, on instructions,
undertakes to repay the entire amount within six months.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner(s) by the
Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject
to the following conditions:-

1.That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a
police officer as and when required;

2.That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;

3.That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.

Post again on 21.03.2017.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 17.02.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that though, the petitioner has joined the investigation however, the entire amount has not been paid so far.

Considering the undertaking made before this Court which is reflected in the order dated 17.02.2017, the order dated 17.02.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioner to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed. However, the petitioner shall remain bound by the undertaking made before this Court. If the amount is not paid within the stipulated period, the aggrieved party shall have liberty to revive the present petition.
