This petition seeks quashing of the order of the learned trial Court discharging two accused in the FIR registered at the instance of the petitioner, the two persons being Rattan Lal Sharma and Sat Kalan wife of Rattan Lal Sharma, who are stated to be parents-in-law of the petitioner.

The allegations against the said persons and the co-accused, i.e. the wife of the petitioner, (daughter of the aforesaid persons) and Baljinder Singh, are that, without obtaining a divorce from the petitioner, his wife, Jyoti, ran away with Baljinder Singh, allegedly taking away with her some jewelry and money.

The trial Court having found that the parents had disinherited Jyoti, and for other reasons recorded in the impugned order, discharged the said two persons.

Learned State counsel, on instructions of Head Constable Jastej Singh, submits that as a matter of fact the aforesaid two persons, Rattan Lal Sharma and Sat Kalan have since died and consequently this petition has been rendered infructuous.

The petition stands dismissed as having been rendered
infructuous.
