A.B. Chaudhari, J. (Oral):

Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties. The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.196 dated 22.10.2016, under Sections 406, 420 IPC, PS Bhargo Camp, District Jalandhar on the basis of compounding/compromise. Pursuant to the order dated 30.1.2017, report of the learned JMIC, Jalandhar has been received who has recorded the statements of the parties and reported that the compromise has been effected voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion. In that view of the matter, the petition is allowed and the impugned FIR, along with all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/ compromise however subject to payment of costs of Rs.50,000/- to the State of Punjab through the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar. If the amount is not deposited within four weeks, this order shall come to an end automatically without further

reference to this Court.
