As per the averments in the petition (in para 4 thereof), two FIR's i.e. FIR No. 208 dated 26.03.2017 and FIR No. 210 dated 26.03.2017 were registered with similar allegations of the petitioner alongwith one Dheeraj enticing away the complainant's daughter aged 16 ½ years on the pretext of marriage. However, a perusal of the vernacular copy of the said FIR's reveals that both the FIR's pertain to different victims (two daughters of the complainant) and allegations have been raised against different set of persons. The translation of these FIR's (Annexures P-1 and P-2) is incorrect and misleading.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that it is due to an inadvertent mistake that correct translation of FIR No.208 and FIR No. 210 could not be appended and certain averments in the petition are not as per the record due to an unintentional oversight. It is further submitted that there is no intention to conceal any facts. An unconditional apology is tendered. She seeks to withdraw this petition, at this stage, with liberty to file afresh with complete and better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforementioned, subject to deposit of ₹ 7000/- as costs with the High Court Legal Services Authority.
