The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.348 dated 25.09.2006 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 & 149 IPC at Police Station Kharar, District Mohali, in view of compromise.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2/complainant submits that compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court had made an order dated 02.03.2017 asking for recording of statement in order to find out the correctness and genuineness of the compromise said to have been arrived at between the parties.

Accordingly, statements have been recorded by the trial Court and report has been received by this Court. Looking to the report it is seen that the compromise is voluntary and genuine. I have seen the

offences registered against the petitioner. Looking to the nature of the offence I think the compromise/compounding should be allowed.

In view of the above, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-41677 OF 2016 is allowed.
- (ii) The FIR No.348 dated 25.09.2006 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 & 149 IPC at Police Station Kharar, District Mohali, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings, qua the petitioner.
