Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.220 dated 10.05.2016 under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Petitioner remained Gram Sachiv of Gram Panchayat, village Chhara, District Jhajjar for the period from 01.08.2010 to 31.03.2013.

At this stage, learned State Counsel on instructions from SI Rajesh Kumar, states that acting on the application moved by the petitioner, the BDPO concerned has given a re-look into the matter and has found the petitioner innocent, therefore, petitioner is not required in the case.

In view of the aforesaid fact that the petitioner has been found innocent, the present petition is disposed of, at this stage, for the reason that

as on date petitioner is not an accused in the FIR. However, in case the

petitioner feels that the police is reopening the case, in any manner, he would be given at least two weeks' prior notice before initiating any action.
