As per Registry, service is complete. However, none has appeared on behalf of respondent No.2.

Petitioner-Darshan Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in complaint case No.RT/52 dated 30.10.2010, titled as 'Surjit Singh vs. Jagsir Singh and others', under Sections 336, 452, 395, 379, 447, 511, 506, 427, 348 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, pending in the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Moga.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1-State and contested this petition.

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I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner absented from the court proceedings; his bail was cancelled and warrant of arrest was issued against him.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 01.11.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court and vide order dated 02.11.2017 passed by the trial Court, he has been released on interim bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find that trial of the case will take a long time, therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody. Therefore, finding merit in this petition, the same is allowed. The order dated 01.11.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
