Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that initially FIR was registered for the offences under Sections 307, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC and under Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, but during course of investigation, offence under Section 307 IPC was deleted and petitioner was granted regular bail. Subsequently, there was enlargement in the culpability qua Baljit Singh who allegedly fired a gun shot.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI, Ashwani stated that pursuant to order dated 22.11.2016, petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

In view of aforesaid, order dated 22.11.2016 is made absolute.
